

As part on the future development plans for the Parks, as you know I have been pushing for the railings along Station Avenue and Brundholme Road to be painted. To add further to elevating the appearance of the parks, I am proposing to fix some small shield type signs at intervals onto the park railings. To this end I have asked Keswick Signs to prepare a design using their very effective ' Park Logo' together with a graphic representation of the Moot Hall. I forward his proposals for consideration. As I understand the railings will be repainted in green, my strong preference is the white sign on the bottom left of these illustrations. I envisage the signs would be reproduced in painted enamel on metal plate approx. 120mm high and fixed with stainless steel small self tapping screws to the vertical railings at about 10 metres spacing to be fixed after painting. I envisage these could also be fixed along Hope Park railings. Subject to agreement by the Trustees on the principle and design, I propose to get a cost for approval at the next meeting.
