Parks Manager Report May 2022

Christine Fawcett

Spring is now on it way; grass is being cut and deciduous trees and shrubs are bursting into leaf and flower. Thanks goes to all the staff for their continued hard work within the parks and office.

Hope Park

The obstacle golf course has been repainted and is as popular as ever with visitors

The greens have all been fertilized and starting to grow. With the cooler conditions in April, they have taken longer than average time to respond. Given the high volume of people using the course over the Easter holidays the greens are standing up well and will be fertilized again in May. The greens have also been treated with lawn sand to reduce moss and vertil knifed to encourage new growth.

Two more memorial benches have been sold and installed within the park and thanks must go to ladies within the office for all their work in this process.

The bedding plants have arrived and are all housed in the green house, being grown on until ready to plant out in early June. Parks staff are on a rota for weekend watering as the days become longer, plants will not last the weekend without water. Litter bins are being emptied at weekend too as part of this rota.



The polyanthus and Algrave tulips have provided a lovely display this spring. The polyanthus will be removed in late May and some of these



plants will be replanted for naturalizing in the woodland at Hope Park and in shrub beds in Upper Fitz park.

A perennial wildflower mix called woodland edge has been sown along part of the footpath in the woodland to provide interest and biodiversity. This seed mix is designed for shaded areas and should provide a haven

for wildlife.

Over the easter weekend Kerry Irving carried out a memorial walk for Max passing through the park via Max's bench. Donations from this event have been big to say the least and I thank everyone who has donated their money towards the upkeep of Hope Park. A big thank you to Kerry, Angela, Paddy and Harry for their continued support. Max you are the miracle dog.

Townsfield

The grass has been cut in April for the first time this season and will continue to be cut twice a month until October. The Keswick Ram Fair will return on Thursday 19th May.

Lower Fitz Park

Grass cutting of Lower Fitz has begun and is being carried out on twice monthly basis.

The play area has been very busy over the Easter Break and replacement parts have been fitted to various pieces of equipment. Including a new seat to the high swings.

Replacement parts have been ordered for the Kanope multi play and include platform, support beams and steps. These parts will be fitted as soon as possible.

The fence from the BMX track to Brundholme road has been replaced as agreed from last year's budget.

The Three user combi system in the outdoor gym has been removed so it can be repaired, an engineer from Street scape is booked to repair the equipment in the next few weeks.

Upper Fitz Park

The tennis courts, bowling green and surrounding grassed areas have been aeriated and fertilizer has been applied. An application of moss killer and herbicide to control turf weeds has been carried out and scarifying to remove the moss will continue throughout the summer.

The bowling green, and putting area have been open since 14th April and the tennis courts have been marked out for the 1st May, weather permitting on play.

The magnolia tree provided a stunning display of flowers in March this year and managed to avoid the early morning frosts.



The new benches have been fitted beside the bowling green as approved at the last meeting and the cast iron benches removed.





The structure in the top sensory garden unfortunately suffered from wind damage in February. The timber frame was beyond repair and has been removed. We are now in the process of paving the area and will be adding seating and planting later in the year.





A wildflowers mix called Dragonfly have been sown along the footpath edge and is just showing signs of germination.

Wivell

The grass around the War Memorial is now being cut, strimmed and maintained by parks staff once a week, ground conditions have improved near the new bus shelter and any holes filled in. Weeds have been sprayed around the hard landscaping of the War Memorial and adjoining footpaths.

Staff Development

The gardening staff visited RHS Bridgewater for a day in April and enjoyed there day picking up some interesting ideas for the parks.

Matt, David and I attended the BIGGA Turf Management Exhibition in Harrogate in March. This was very informative of new products coming onto the market and helpful for future projects within the parks.
